Dear Control Data Customer:

The NOS Full Screen Editor (FSE) will be available in the NOS V2.2 release. This feature allows on-line full screen editing as well as line editing. The Full Screen Editor allows the inserting and changing of characters, moving and copying lines, paging through a file, global locate and changing commands, and supports split screen (multiple file) editing. There is also the ability to UNDO any changes made to a file, procedures of editor commands, word processing commands (paragraph fill, line split and join, centering), and user programmable function keys.

The FSE provides both a high performance multi-user subsystem and a conventional copy-per-user program. The multi-user subsystem utilizes extended memory to provide hundreds of terminals on a large mainframe with rapid response times. Screen editing is supported on the CDC 721, CDC 722, DEC VT100, and Zenith Z19 full screen terminals and line mode can be used on other terminals.

There has been significant interest in the Full Screen Editor. Control Data will be making the "copy-per-user" editor program available as a feature supported on NOS V2.1. This feature will be available through the regular licensing procedures. The product number for the Full Screen Editor is:

- H8X5-37 for 170-800 series mainframes
- H7X0-37 for 170-700 series mainframes
- H521-37 for 170-17X, 7X, 6XXX, 176 mainframes

The Full Screen Editor is a successor product to XEDIT. Please contact your CDC sales office for complete product information.
